The piece is in 8 parts and the order of the piece is decided upon with an election. All of the parts are not “running for office”, W, X and Z have a fixed pace within the piece as the following chart shows;

As you can see are some of the parts omitted from playing, based on the outcome of the election. To have all of the part played in one concert the option to use the dictator rule is optional. The order would then be as following;

B , W , Z , A , E , C , D , X

The election should be amongst the audience, either before the concert would start or in the intermission. It would also be possible to make an query on the internet and have the election well before the concert.

The orchestra can also decide amongst themselves on the order of the parts and play the piece thus.

Pauses in between parts depend solely on the eagerness of the conductor.
